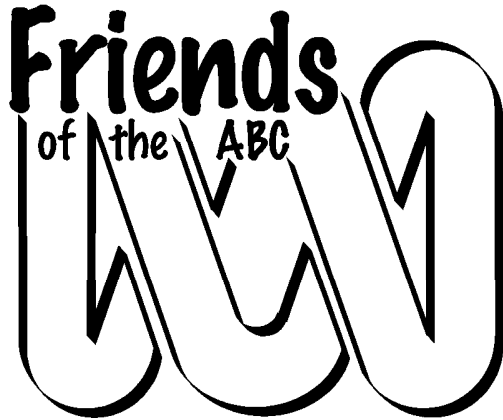


About
